Remembering June

1963 – Soviet space mission Vostok 6 is launched with Valentina Tereshkova the first woman in space aboard. Top song "Sukiyaki" by Kyu Sakamoto. AHS Class of 63 graduates.

1968 – Presidential candidate Bobbie Kenedy is assassinated after a campaign speech in Los Angeles. Top song "Mrs. Robinson" by Simon & Garfunkel. AHS Class of 68 graduates.

1973 – Secretariat wins the Belmont Stakes to become the first Triple Crown winner in 25 years. Top song "My Love" by Paul McCartney and Wings. AHS Class of 73 graduates.

1978 – Movie "Grease" starring Olivia Newton-John and John Travolta premiers. Top song "Shadow Dancing" by Andy Gibb. AHS Class of 78 graduates.

1983 – Challenger 2 launches with Sally Ride the first US woman in space aboard. Top song "Flashdance...What a Feeling" by Irene Cara. AHS Class of 83 graduates.

1988 – A concert supporting jailed anti-apartheid Nelson Mandela in London was attended by 80,000 people. Top song "One more Try" by George Michael. AHS Class of 88 graduates.

1993 – American singer Prince celebrates his birthday by changing his name to an unpronounceable symbol. Top song "That's the Way Love Goes" by Janet Jackson. AHS Class of 93 graduates.

1998– The US Supreme Court rules the Line-Item Veto Act of 1996 is unconstitutional. The top song "This Boy is Mine" by Brandy and Monica. AHS Class of 1998 graduates.

2003 – The 46th Annual Merced West Coast Fly-in was celebrated with 700 aircraft on display during the three-day event. Top song was "21 Questions" by 50 Cent. AHS Class of 03 graduates.

2008 – Same sex marriage was legalized in the state of California. Top song "Lollipop" by Lil Wayne. AHS Class of 08 graduates.

2013 – The US charges NSA leaker Edward Snowden with violations of the Espionage Act. Top song "Can't Hold Us" by Macklemore & Ryan Lewis. AHS Class of 2013 graduates.
